 - a. Identify themselves as a student-athlete
 - b. Sell items and gear that they own

- 4. Student-athlete (and prospective student-athletes) NO
 - a. Pay for play, an NIL activity must occur
 - b. Compensation in exchange for participation
 - c. Compensation based on participation, awards or performance
- 5. Student-athlete GET PERMISSION FIRST "follow campus process"
 - a. College facility use
 - b. College Marks for compensation
 - c. Action photos, graphics, videos for athletic events or team activities for compensation.
 - d. Wearing uniform for compensation
- 6. College Employee YES
 - a. Provide NIL education
 - b. Assist SA vetting agents
- 7. College Employee NO
 - a. Direct involvement with current or prospective SA's NIL Transaction
 - b. Arrange or represent current or prospective SA's as an agent
